### Basic Items

Bedding will be provided by Leeson House Field Studies Centre
A pair of clean, indoor shoes. Slippers could be used. For safety reasons, no novelty slippers or flip flops!
Plastic bin liner for wet or dirty clothes
Clean casual clothes for indoor wear
A towel, wash kit and nightwear
Swimming costume and beach towels
Some people like to bring additional snacks although plenty is provided

### Field Work Kit List

Hard hats are essential, please bring your own **
Waterproof coat and if possible, waterproof trousers
Walking boots, or strong low-heeled shoes or outdoor trainers
Old jeans, joggers, etc (2 pairs or more), shorts in summer
Warm fleece jumper/jacket
Wellington boots – essential for those studying rivers and rock pools
Sunhat and protective sun-screening lotion for sunnier days
2 sweaters/sweatshirt
Several pairs of socks, at least one thick pair

### Equipment

Small day rucksack and a suitable container for packed lunch
Re-fillable watertight bottle for the packed lunch drink as we do not provide bottles
Stationary for notetaking – notebook and pens
Geology hammer, chisel, magnifying glass are optional but if you bring a hammer you will need protective goggles
